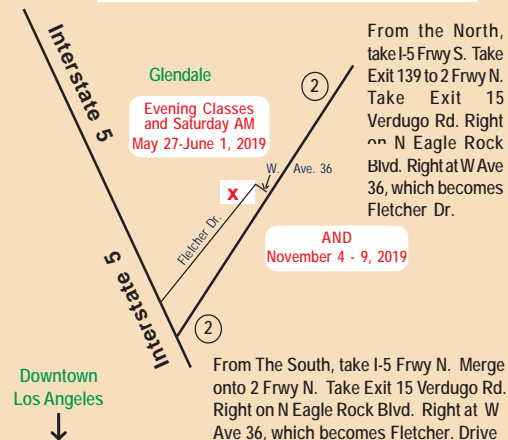

The **Chaplains Training Academy** (CTA) has been established to serve Chaplains and trainees by providing training in Biblical expertise, as well as a **Credential** validating and sanctioning them as approved and fit for gospel ministry within a correctional facility.

The program consists of four individual training Quarters. If needed, evening or week-end classes can be scheduled. Enrollment will be from 12 to 20 students per session. Homework and outside course work will be required.

Upon satisfactory completion of an individual Quarter session, a student will earn five units.

A CREDENTIAL sanctioning the trainee as an approved "Fit for Biblical Correctional Chaplaincy" minister, will be given upon the completion of 20 units.

See the **sample** Credential to the right, below. Normally it takes 19 months, but a student must finish in 30 months, to earn their Credential.

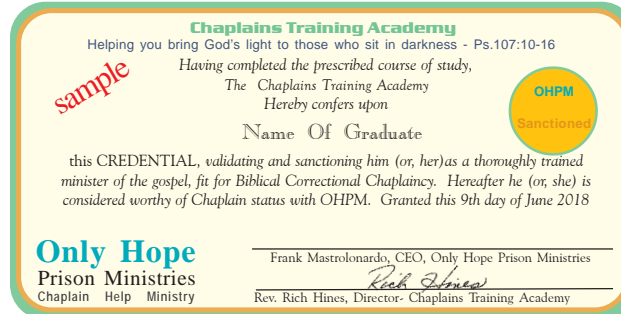
Cost

New students will cost \$100. because of extra textbooks. \$90 for third and fourth time Students.

**In 2018-19 the Academy will hold four one-week training sessions, possibly more:
in St. Charles, IL, Sept. 24-29, 2018 & April 1-6, 2019
in Los Angeles, CA, May 27 - June 1, 2019
and again in Los Angeles, CA, Nov. 4 - 9, 2019
and possibly in Imperial, CA, in the Winter of 2019**
